IMPORTANT VET PROCEDURE

An Equine Health Form will be sent in a separate email. A \$40.00 Vet fee is required for each privately owned horse. The fee covers an initial exam of the horse determining general health, fitness, and suitability. It also covers a Ride Vet being available for horses before, during, & after the Ride on tie lines, in camp, & on the trail. Fee also covers any exams during the ride. Treatments and medications will be charged separately. Please have completed Health Form, \$40.00 fee (checks made to Dr. Kristina Grewal) at check-in on Sunday, May 12. Island horses will check-in at Little Harbor.

WAIVER AND RELEASE 2019

Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement Please read CAREFULLY before signing.

-THIS RELEASE IS A LEGAL AND BINDING DOCUMENT-

THIS IS A WAIVER OF RIGHTS AND AN AGREEMENT NOT TO SUE. YOU ARE GIVING UP LEGAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT. THE SIGNING OF THIS DOCUMENT IS A CONDITION PRIOR TO ENTERING ONTO THE CATALINA ISLAND CONSERVANCY PROPERTY.

I, _____, acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate in certain recreational activities including without limitation horseback riding, hiking, swimming, camping with the Las Caballeras club on Catalina Island, California. I understand that horseback riding is a dangerous and hazardous athletic event and any horse environment poses potentially serious risks of injuries to its participants and or observers. I understand that I, or my horse, may be injured as a result of my negligence, the negligence of others, or through no fault of myself or anyone else, because of the nature of the activity in which I am going to be engaged or observed. I also understand that horses, even the most well-trained, are often unpredictable and often difficult to control, and that no one has represented or stated to me that horses are "safe" or have any specific or particular qualities.

Assumption of risk:

I acknowledge that trail rides, and all events and activities ("Activities") associated with the Las Caballeras Catalina Ride (the "Ride") on Catalina Island, California, are dangerous activities and that participation in activities as a participant, an individual contractor, or volunteer (collectively "Participant"), exposes the Participant to substantial and serious risk of property damage, personal injury or death to me or my horse, and hereby agree to accept and assume any and all risks, and release and hold harmless all of the persons or entities mentioned herein who, through negligence, carelessness, or otherwise be liable to me, my heirs and assigns, for damages, or injury or death, and verify this statement by placing my initials here: _____

Release:

Being fully aware that participation in the Activities will expose me to substantial and serious risk of property damage and/or personal injury or death, and in consideration for having been given permission to enter upon that real property commonly known as Santa Catalina Island, and to participate in the Activities, I release (i) **Las Caballeras, any of its associated organizations, including but not limited to the Santa Catalina Island Conservancy, the Santa Catalina Island Company and its subsidiaries- E.R.E. Ventures LLC, E.R.E. LLC, USC Wrigley Institute of Environmental Studies, Kangaru Enterprises LLC, L.A. County Department of Parks and Recreation, The City of Rolling Hills Estates, and Catalina Island Saddle Club** and/or any successor in interest, and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, employees, and agents of each entity or organization and (ii) any member of the **Wrigley, Offield, or Rusack** families, their heirs, personal representatives, successors, and assigns or any trusts created by them or for their benefit (collectively the "Releasees") from liability for any and all claims for loss and/or damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me or my heirs as a result of my participation in the Activities which may be sustained, including any claims that are known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen, future or contingent.

Welcome to the 24th Las Caballeras Catalina Ride!

Since this riding opportunity is unique, and we can accommodate a very limited number of riders, we usually sell out. Priority registration is given to members until April 1st, then applications are accepted in the order received based on postmark. When we reach capacity, additional applications are put on a standby list. Riders are notified once their application is accepted. If we have a cancellation, riders are added from the standby list. We cannot process incomplete applications, so before you send yours in, you might want to check the following:

1. Is your application complete and legible?
2. Is your Waiver & Release signed and dated?
3. Have you included payment? Don't forget to sign the check.
4. Do you have correct postage on the envelope?
5. Mail to: Las Caballeras, P O Box 2403, Avalon, CA 90704

If you do all of the above and mail your application in early, there's a good chance you'll make the list.

Here's the Process:

First week of March – Applications go out.

April 1 – Riders whose applications are accepted are notified via email. FYGs and their sponsors are then contacted by the FYG Mom. (If you have sent in an application and haven't heard from us by that date, you need to contact us.)

Mid-April – Ride packets are sent out via email as additional riders are accepted. Once capacity is reached, additional applicants are put on a standby list. Checks are held pending acceptance. If applicants cannot be accommodated, their check will be returned.

May 12, 12 noon – Riders drop off horses and gear at Ernie Howlett Park and check in with the vet. Riders arrange their own Sunday night accommodations and dinner.

May 13, early AM – Barges with horses and equipment depart San Pedro for Two Harbors. Riders grab breakfast Monday morning before checking in at San Pedro Catalina Express terminal.

May 13, 8:45 AM – Boat departs San Pedro Catalina Express terminal for Two Harbors. If you miss the boat, we're sorry, but you'll have to arrange your own transportation to Two Harbors and camp.

May 13, 10:45 AM – Boat arrives at Two Harbors. Riders can grab a Buffalo Milk or bite to eat. Horses are transported to Little Harbor picket line. Riders are transported to Little Harbor to set up camp. Yeehaw! The fun begins!

P.K. Wrigley once said, "The only way Catalina will ever be thoroughly seen and appreciated is from horseback." We couldn't agree more. Whether you're slowly picking your way through scrub oaks and prickly pear on a heavily-worn bison trail, or winding your way along a mountain ridge, you will be able to experience some unforgettable trail rides. You'll need to prepare your horse for the experience. Catalina is a rocky mountain range surrounded by water. If your horse is barefoot and you normally ride on the flats, you'll want to condition him on hills well before the ride, and consider shoes. We don't have a farrier on the island. You will need to have your horse reshod a week or two before the ride. If you prefer to keep your mount barefoot, we recommend you bring boots along. You'd hate to miss riding because your horse is foot sore. If your horse does develop a medical problem, we have a ride vet on hand. She and our wranglers keep a close watch on the horses day and night, to try to catch and treat problems early. When the dust clears at the end of the ride, we want you to love this ride, and this island, as much as we do.

LC+ Horse Trailering Procedure 2019

Horses are transported to/from Catalina Island in stock trailers. This cost is included in your ride fee. You may reserve a divider trailer space for your horse for an additional fee of \$175 round trip from Ernie Howlett Park to/from Catalina.

If you choose this option, THIS FEE IS IN ADDITION TO YOUR RIDE FEE & NEEDS TO BE A SEPARATE CHECK.

This option is limited and offered on a first come, first served basis. Your check will be held until your horse's divided trailer slot is confirmed. If there isn't enough room, your check will be returned.

Our stock trailers do not accommodate tall/warmblood size horses (16.2hh and above), so we have a warmblood size horse trailer available at the additional \$175 fee. Due to health & safety concerns, tall/warmblood size horses have first priority for these spaces. It is highly recommended that you reserve one of these spaces if you have a tall/large horse.

In order to reserve a divider trailer space, you need to mail in the Reservation Form below and separate payment by check in the amount of \$175 made out to Las Caballeras. We recommend that you do this as soon as possible, since we have a limited number of divider spaces available. Your divider trailer space request and payment does not have to be included with your ride application, but we recommend that you do to increase your chances of getting a space.

Horses will be assigned into the divider trailers as follows:

1. Horses 16.2hh and above.
2. By seniority, based on number of Catalina rides a rider has attended. In the case of a tie, the rider having attended a Catalina ride at the earliest date takes precedence.
3. By current year member priority number.
4. SYGs by earliest postmark.
5. FYGs by earliest postmark.

An email reservation confirmation will be sent to each rider receiving a divider space. After the divider trailer space assignments are made, we will have a waiting list for any unassigned divider spaces that may become available.

If you sign up for a divider stall and one is not available, your \$175 will be refunded.

FYGs and SYGs: The "Camper Only" option is available for members only and not available to First or Second Year Guests.
