



2008 DUES

Yes, this is early, but we'd like to ask your help. Catalina Freight Lines increased our rate dramatically this year. With fewer riders than usual on the Catalina ride, we fell short of the mark. If you can pay your 2008 dues early, we could use the extra cash right now. PLEASE GIVE US YOUR SUPPORT!

We are offering several dues options this year.

1. E-Associate Membership (\$30) – This covers email communications, newsletters, etc. If you decide to attend the Catalina ride, you will be required to pay a \$50 upgrade to Full Membership along with your ride fee.
2. Associate Membership (\$50) – All communication is via US Mail. If you decide to attend the Catalina ride, you will be required to pay a \$50 upgrade to Full Membership along with your ride fee.
3. Full Membership (\$80) – All communication is via email, which includes announcements, newsletters, eligibility to purchase logowear, etc. You will also get a copy of the ride book, which contains pictures from the Catalina ride, contact information on all our members, and much more. It will be mailed in October following the Catalina ride. Even if you miss the ride, you won't want to miss your copy of the Ride Book.
4. 5-year Full Membership dues special (\$300) – Prepay for the best pricing.

NOTE: If you have attended a previous LC+ Catalina Ride as either a member or a FYG, and are not current in your dues, you will be required to pay the current First Year Guest (FYG) ride fee in order to attend the ride.
